



1. Position the bracket where it would be difficult for a would be thief to attack.
2. With the bracket in place, mark the position of the 4 holes.
3. Attach the bracket with raw plugs if required and phillips type screws (not supplied).  
Once attached, it is advisable to drill the head of the screw so the bracket cannot be easily removed.

Should you wish to obtain additional keys, a local locksmith maybe able to cut them for you.
