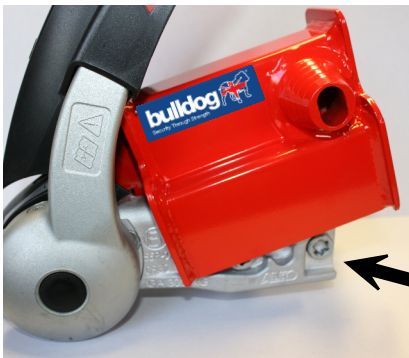




1. To remove the lock, insert the key and turn clockwise until key stops then pull gently to

2. With the stabiliser handle in the upright position, lift the hitch handle and insert the dummy ball.



3. Tilt the hitchlock to locate the front lip into the recess at the front of the handle. Once in position, lower the hitchlock over the handle.

(Please Note: If there are 2 or more threads protruding from the nut, the length of the bolt will have to be reduced for the hitchlock to fit)



4. Partially insert the lock and turn the key a quarter turn and gently push into the lock housing.

Should you wish to obtain additional keys, a local locksmith may be able to copy one of the original keys.
